1. Junior Kid (April 1st and later)

1. All Saanens (Purebred, American, Grade and Experimental) are eligible for entry. There are two divisions: 1) Purebred & American, and 2) Grade & Experimental. Grades and Experimental must be at least 50% Saanen and must meet Saanen breed standard.
2. Each animal must have competed in at least one official ADGA show within the age year for which the animal is being nominated, and was awarded at least one of the following:
 - A. First or Second in an ADGA individual class.
 - B. Best of Breed, Grand Champion Senior, Reserve Champion Senior, Grand Champion Junior, Reserve Champion Junior at an ADGA sanctioned show.
3. Owned by a current member of NSBA, either at the time the award was won, or at the time of submission.
4. Submission of one completed Individual Nomination Form and copy of pedigree for each nominated animal is required (can use 3rd generation from subscription reports).
5. Required views are Standard Side Profile; Rear View of Udder and Legs; and Topline Rump to Withers taken from above rear quarters. Photos must be labeled with registered name of the goat. Applications without all views will be rejected.
6. Photos should be submitted in JPEG format and must be at least 150KB.
7. No awards, ribbons or trophies in the photos. The handler must be cropped out above the shoulders. Photos sent with any identifying information in the photo will be rejected.
8. Photos must be taken during the year for which the entry is made.
9. Photos of All American and Reserve All American will be retained by NSBA for use in news releases, on our web site, on our Facebook page, etc.
10. Entry deadline is November 15th. **No late entries will be accepted.**
11. Entry is free to all NSBA members. Anyone can join NSBA at the time of nomination(s) if they are not a current NSBA member. Online membership must be paid before the entry/entries will be accepted.
12. Any winning entry determined to be a misrepresentation of the animal will be removed, and a correction will be published in the next issue of the Saanen News and online where needed.
