NSBA Linear Appraisal Recognition Program Rules for 85 or higher scores

ALL Applications must be postmarked by December 1st

1. All Saanens (Purebreds, Americans, Grades and Experimentals) will be eligible for recognition. Grades and Experimentals must be at least 50% Saanen and must meet Saanen breed standard
2. Adult Bucks/Does and Young Stock Bucks/Does must be owned by current paid member of NSBA, with dues paid on or before September 1st. All does and bucks must be owned by the person submitting the records. Supreme entries may be owned by other breeders, see rules 6 & 7. Animals maybe enter even if you sell them before the entry period. Make sure you copy their records before you sell them.
3. Entry is free for NSBA members. A certificate will be issued for an additional \$1 per animal.
4. Entry deadline is December 1st of each year.
5. Entries accepted for current year's appraisal session only for Adult and Young Stock Animals.
6. **Additional Rules for Supreme Dam and Daughters**
May be owned by other Breeders but at least one must be owned by you in the current year and you must be a current paid member of NSBA, with dues paid on or before September 1st. Entries will be accepted for previous year's appraisal sessions for either Supreme Dam or Daughters but at least one must be LA in the current year. Supreme Dam and Daughter both must Linear Appraise 90 or higher. We are requesting, but not requiring, a Photo (JPG) of the Supreme Dam & Daughter to use for promotion of the LA program.
7. **Additional Rules for Supreme Sire and Daughters**
May be owned by other Breeders but at least one must be owned by you in the current year and you must be a current paid member of NSBA, with dues paid on or before September 1st. Entries will be accepted for previous year's appraisal sessions for either Supreme Sire or Daughters but at least one must be LA in the current year. Supreme Sires do not need to be Linear Appraised and his scores are not needed to enter but can be. The three daughters must be Linear Appraised 90 or higher. We are requesting, but not requiring, a Photo (JPG) of the Supreme Sire & Daughter to use for promotion of the LA program.
8. Recognition Program results plus Photos (JPG) of Supreme Dam with Daughter and the three daughters from the Supreme Sires will be published in the Saanen Newsletter, at the NSBA web site, and on the NSBA face book page. They will also be submitted to United Caprine News and Dairy Goat Journal for publication.
9. Send the following : (A) An Application with your entries listed (B) Copy of each goat's registration certificate (C) Copy of the 2014 Linear Appraisal sheet (white typed sheet from ADGA office). The same must be submitted for Supreme Animals (D) Photo (JPG) of Supreme animals (not required)

 A copy of the 2014 Linear Appraisal Sheet (white typed sheet from ADGA office)
 A Photo of Supreme Dam with Daughter (JPG) (not required)
